

The following is a list of Panorama screens/functions which will not be used in Nova Scotia but are still visible to the end-user. This list **does not** include individual fields which have been deemed out-of-scope.

Fields that are Panorama mandatory and which will not be used in Nova Scotia will have one value “Do Not Use” to be selected in order to save the form.

Functions/Screen	Comments
<b>Client/Subject</b>	
Risk Factors	Reported By Details field is disabled
<b>Investigation</b>	
Diagnostic Imaging Quick Entry	Do not complete the Physician’s Recommendations section
Encounters	Panorama auto-generates Encounters from certain screens (see Tips & Tricks #8 for a list) which will appear on the subject/investigation summary screens. IGNORE all encounters and do not click Create Encounter buttons.  When in Recent Work, do not select hyperlinks of the type ENC:.
Episodes	Episodes is a method to group Encounters. As with Encounters, Episodes will not be used. Do not click the Episode button.
Exposures/Transmission Event Control Measures	This section will not be used.
External Sources	Do not complete Index Provider or SDL sections.  Only the Other External Sources section will be used.
Lab Requisition	When a lab result is entered and saved, a lab report and lab requisition are automatically generated. Panorama lab requisitions will not be used and can be ignored.
Treatment Profile	The Treatment Profile section of this screen will not be used.
<b>Outbreak</b>	
Communications	The outbreak communications screen will not be used.
Lab Summary	The outbreak lab summary screen will not be used.

Wait Queue	Wait Queue functionality will not be used.
