


Influenza Lab reporting 2019-2020 Season.

Positive Influenza lab- client NOT hospitalized

Create an investigation and within the investigation complete

- Disease summary- Disease Event Details
- Investigation Information-
 - Ensure that the Client Home address at time of initial investigation reflects Postal Code
- Responsible / Investigator Organization
- Reporting Source
- Link lab to the investigation
- Outcome
- Close investigation

Positive Influenza Lab on a hospitalized client

 For weekly follow up *week 1* would be the week that you received the positive lab report

Create an investigating and within the investigation complete

- Disease Summary- Complete Disease Event Details
- Investigation Information
 - Ensure that the Client Home address at time of initial investigation reflects Postal Code
- Responsible / Investigator Organization
- Reporting Source
- Link the lab result
- Indigenous Information- update at the Client level and in the Disease Event
- Add signs and symptoms- Set an onset date
- Add outcome- Follow up weekly on hospitalized patients until discharged or death (maximum of 4 weeks – add an outcome for each week in Outcomes of Panorama
- Risk Factors-
 - medical risk factor-preset- Unimmunized or incomplete immunization history
 - To be added- Special consideration- pregnant or less than 6 weeks post-partum
- Close investigation- after client discharge/death or maximum 4 week follow up has been completed.

Any additional labs are received (i.e. typing) are added to the lab portion of the investigation.
